World Olympian Association OLY Process:

- 1. MNAs contact their Sailing Olympians to make them aware of the opportunity
- 2. Sailors who have competed in an Olympic Games submit their details on a simple form on www.Olympians.org
- 3. Eligibility is checked against the International Olympic Committee's Games Competition results database
- 4. Upon verification an electronic certificate is sent to the sailor
- 5. An MNA who decides to hold a presentation to recognise this honour, tells World Sailing and provides us with the names of sailors
- 6. World Sailing check the list of sailors with the WOA and receive hard copy certificates and pins and other supporting material as required by the MNA (slides, speech notes)
- 7. World Sailing send material to the MNA
- 8. Presentation takes place, and sailors are presented with OLY pins and certificates by their MNA
